Join Us as We Celebrate the Grand Opening of Lions Bay Beach Park

After years of planning, construction, and anticipation, the Beach Park Revitalization Project is complete, and we are excited to invite the community to celebrate this important milestone.

Please join Mayor and Council immediately prior to the commencement of Wednesday's Canada Day festivities for the official Grand Opening and Ribbon Cutting Ceremony at 12:00 noon sharp. The ceremony will begin with welcoming remarks from Mayor Ken Berry, who will recognize the many individuals and organizations that helped bring this significant community project to fruition, including funding partners, consultants, contractors, municipal staff, volunteers, and the patience and support of the Lions Bay community throughout construction.

We are also pleased to welcome Patrick Weiler, Member of Parliament for West Vancouver–Sunshine Coast–Sea to Sky Country, and Jeremy Valeriote, MLA for West Vancouver–Sea to Sky, who will offer remarks recognizing the importance of this revitalized community amenity and the partnerships that helped make it possible.

The ceremony will conclude with the official ribbon cutting by Mayor Berry, MP Patrick Weiler, MLA Jeremy Valeriote, and Members of Council, formally opening the revitalized Beach Park for residents and visitors to enjoy.

The Beach Park Revitalization Project represents a significant investment in one of Lions Bay's most treasured public spaces. The project has transformed the park with new public amenities, improved accessibility, upgraded infrastructure, enhanced landscaping, modernized pay structure facilities, and other improvements that will serve the community for many years to come.
