### New Bus Stop Now Open at Isleview and Lions Bay Avenue



We are pleased to announce that the new BC Transit bus stop at the intersection of Isleview Road and Lions Bay Avenue is now operational and available for public use.

The new stop improves transit accessibility and forms part of the Municipality's ongoing efforts to enhance transportation options and support safer, more convenient travel throughout the community. To further improve the rider experience, a new bus shelter will be installed in the coming weeks, providing passengers with protection from the weather while waiting for transit service.

We thank residents for their patience during construction and hope the new stop provides a safe, comfortable, and convenient transit connection for the community.

# LIONS BAY FIRE RESCUE

## FIRE CHIEF'S WEEKLY UPDATE



Good day, Lions Bay,

As I wrapped up my first full week as Fire Chief, I wanted to take a moment to share a few highlights and provide an update on some of the work already underway at Lions Bay Fire Rescue.

First, I would like to thank everyone for the incredibly warm welcome my family and I have received. We were especially impressed by the hospitality, pride, and community spirit on display during the Canada Day celebrations.

Having the opportunity to attend the official opening of Lions Bay Beach Park with my daughters was particularly memorable. It was an honor to be part of such a special community event, and it reinforced what makes Lions Bay such a wonderful place to live, work, and serve.

This week, we officially began implementing **Ember Tracking**, a modern department management system developed in British Columbia. Once fully operational, the system will improve how we manage training records, equipment maintenance, apparatus inspections, inventory, personnel records, and operational reporting. This is an exciting step forward as we continue modernizing the department.

We have also started making improvements around the fire hall, including repairs and upgrades to our lighting to create a safer and more functional working environment for our firefighters. In addition, we have established a dedicated workstation in the apparatus bay for firefighters and officers to support digital record management, including incident reporting, data entry, training records, inspections, and other administrative functions. This is another step toward improving efficiency and modernizing our day-to-day operations.

Next week, members will be conducting a comprehensive inventory of all apparatus, equipment, personal protective equipment (PPE), and fire hall assets. This important project will provide the foundation for improved asset management, maintenance scheduling, and future planning to ensure we continue providing the highest level of emergency service to our community.

These initiatives represent only the beginning. Over the coming weeks and months, we will continue strengthening our operational readiness, enhancing our facilities, and investing in systems that support both our firefighters and the residents we proudly serve.

Thank you once again for making my family and me feel so welcome. I look forward to working alongside our dedicated firefighters, Village staff, Council, and the

residents of Lions Bay as we continue building an even stronger fire service together.

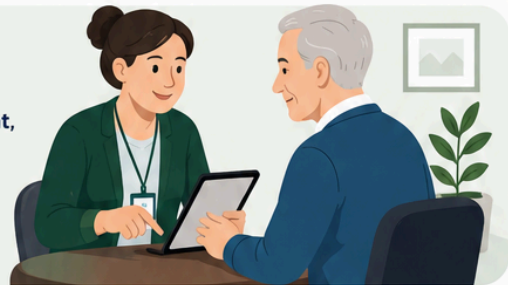
