UPDATES FROM MUNICIPALITY

Structure Fire in Kelvin Grove

At approximately 4:10 a.m. on Sunday, July 19, Lions Bay Fire Rescue responded to a residential structure fire in the Kelvin Grove neighbourhood.

Under our Mutual Aid Agreement, West Vancouver Fire & Rescue Services also responded to assist with fire suppression and exposure protection.

The fire was contained to the structure of origin, and there were no injuries to emergency responders. The incident remains under investigation.

During the fire department's response, the high demand placed on the Village water system may have stirred up naturally occurring sediment and introduced air into the water lines. As a result, some residents may notice cloudy water, air sputtering from taps, or slight discoloration.

If you experience any of these temporary effects, please run a cold water tap for several minutes until the water runs clear.

There is no need for concern. These conditions are a normal and short-term result of increased water demand, and water quality is expected to return to normal as the system stabilizes. While the water may appear unsightly, it remains safe to drink; however, staff recommend flushing your taps before consuming.
